Did You Know?

A study by Harvard Medical School shows that getting fewer than 6 or 7 hours of sleep per night doubles the risk of cancer, and insufficient sleep is a key lifestyle factor in determining whether someone will develop Alzheimer's Disease. Getting to bed early is also much healthier in general, since non-REM sleep (deeper and more restorative than REM sleep) occurs in the early part of the night.
